And as of now they don't want differently abled people as it will be tough to arrange for transport and other amenities. They are willing to pay 2500/- . They want us to let them know if there is someone who can fit the job.
 - They want to have a small store opened and are in search of a small shop for it. We can see if we can help them procure a shop.
 - They have a future priority to set-up a unit which is run and entirely managed by disabled. Ex: A hand made paper factory.
 - Home of Love - Saransh collect old clothes for them. Setting up of boxes to collect old clothes in our resp comp which will be distributed among the disabled people in the villages.
